AID FOR PART-TIME STUDY

Aid for Part Time Study is a grant program funded by the State of New York designed to provide tuition assistance to eligible NYS undergraduate students who attend college at a less-than-full-time status.

- Are you a matriculated undergraduate student—that is, have you been accepted into a program leading to the completion of a bachelor's degree?
- Are you planning to be a part-time student during either the fall or spring semester of the upcoming academic year?
- Are you a NYS resident?
- Are you a U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, or refugee?
- Do you still have TAP eligibility?

Then, you may want to consider applying for the NYS Aid for Part-Time Study Program (APTS) to assist you with the cost of your tuition here at The College of Saint Rose.

If you feel you may be eligible to participate in the APTS Program for the 2011-2012 academic year, you should review the application and instruction sheet to determine if you meet the eligibility and income criteria. If you meet all the criteria, and you wish to be considered for an APTS Award, complete the application, and forward it and a copy of your 2010 NYS Income Tax Return to the Office of Financial Aid. If parental data is required, attach a copy of your parent's 2010 NYS Tax Return, also. Keep in mind that you use 3 points of your TAP/APTS eligibility each time you receive an APTS Award.

The application deadlines for the upcoming year are as follows Fall Semester – September 23, 2011 Spring Semester – February 10, 2012
