A fan of space exploration and mathematics during her years at Saint Rose, Conroy has landed in a field that combines both, as a software designer at the Harvard-Smithsonian Center for Astrophysics in Cambridge, Mass. There, among other things, she headed the team that designed software for the famous Chandra space telescope.
