Types of Endowed Funds at The College of Saint Rose

The College of Saint Rose offers the following opportunities for establishing named endowed funds with gifts ranging from \$10,000 to \$1.5 million. In order to guarantee that the income from an endowment will be sufficient to achieve the donor's goals, minimum support levels have been established.

Named Deanship – provides flexible resources for deans to meet special needs in their Schools. Minimum to establish an endowment:
Named Faculty Chair - enables the College to attract or retain a faculty member or scholar of academic distinction. Endowment income may provide partial support for the teaching, research and service activities of the chair holder, including funds for expenses such as equipment, scholarly travel, books and research.
Minimum to establish an endowment: \$1,500,000
Named Professorship - recognizes and rewards an outstanding faculty member and assists the College in retaining highly productive, senior faculty members by supporting teaching, research and professional development.
Minimum to establish an endowment: \$500,000
Scholars and Artists Fund - supports faculty participating in research or creative work in special College initiatives.
Minimum to establish endowment: \$250,000
Annually Funded Scholars and Artists Fund:\$10,000 (for 4 years)
New Faculty Scholar Fund - supports newly hired faculty through teaching and professional development in a particular school.
Minimum to establish endowment:
Annually Funded New Faculty Scholar Fund:\$3,000 (for 4 years)
Faculty Development Fund – supports faculty developing their careers through study, research, travel, publishing and professional activities.
Minimum to establish endowment:
Annually Funded Faculty Development Fund:\$3,000 (for 4 years)
Teaching Support Fund – supports the development of new courses, new course materials or experimentation with new teaching approaches.
Minimum to establish endowment:
Annually Funded Teaching Support Fund\$2,000 (for 4 years)
Staff Development Fund – supports staff developing their careers through study, research, travel, publication and professional activities.
Minimum to establish endowment: \$50,000
Annually Funded Staff Development Fund:\$2,000 (for 4 years)

Named Lectureship - supports travel expenses, fees and housing for speakers who enrich the educational experience of students and the intellectual life of the campus and community.
Minimum to establish endowment: \$100,000
Annually Funded Named Lectureship: \$4,000
Performing Arts Series – supports a performing arts series in music, attracting renowned national and international musicians.
Minimum to establish endowment: \$100,000
Annually Funded Performing Arts Series:\$4,000
Visual Arts Series – supports high quality visual arts exhibitions, residencies and instruction to link with community involvement, instruction and collaboration.
Minimum to establish endowment:\$100,000
Annually Funded Visual Arts Series:
Named Student Scholarship - offsets tuition costs based on financial need, academic achievement, or both.
Minimum to establish endowment: \$50,000
Annually Funded Named Student Scholarship:\$2,000 (for 4 years)
Named Student Enhancement Fund - supports undergraduate or graduate student activities within a department or school. Funds may cover research, professional meetings, enrichment activities such as internships, and leadership training.
Minimum to establish endowment:
Annually Funded Named Student Enhancement Fund:\$1,000
Named Student Award - provides a monetary award to recognize a student for dedication to his or her field, or for outstanding academic achievement. Student recipients of named endowed
awards are selected by members of the faculty or a selection committee and may be formally recognized at Honors' Convocation each spring.

Annually Funded Named Student Award: \$400
Named Classroom or Laboratory - supports equipment, technology enhancements, renovations and/or research activities for a new or existing space.

Named Book Fund - allows the purchase books or other materials for the library for a specific field, the preservation of books, cataloging or other library expenses.
Minimum to establish endowment: \$25,000
Annually Funded Named Book Fund: \$1,000
Named Annual Fund Gift - continues a donor's essential support of the College's operations
after his or her lifetime, by transferring income from investment earnings to the unrestricted annual fund. The minimum fund level will result in recognition in the Rooney Society of the
Saint Rose leadership giving club.
