Graduate Survey Highlights Class of 2008 (August '07, December '07, May '08)

The College of Saint Rose Career Center conducted the graduate survey for the Class of 2008. The purpose of this survey was to collect employment and graduate/professional school outcome information for graduates one year after graduation. This year we also collected information related to internship participation of the graduates while they were attending Saint Rose.

Survey responses were collected through on-line surveys, mailings, and follow-up phone calls. These efforts resulted in 809 survey respondents; which is a response rate of 40%. Of those that responded, 21% responded via on-line survey, 21% through hard-copy mailing, and 33% through phone outreach.

To supplement outcome information, we utilized graduate/professional school information from Banner and the National Student Clearinghouse Report; employment information from Alumni Relations & Institutional Advancement; and reached out to faculty, administrators and staff asking them to share employment and continuing education information for non-respondents. This resulted in employment and graduate/ professional school information for an additional 265 graduates; a total of 1,074 – 53% of the graduating class.

Approximately, one year after graduation:

- 96% of respondents were employed or enrolled in graduate/professional school programs
- > 92% of respondents who sought employment were employed
- > 90% of those responding to how long it took to obtain a position, were employed in 6 months or less
- ➤ 95% of those responding to their level of employment preparation, indicated that Saint Rose had prepared them for employment after graduation
- > 52% of undergraduate degree recipients and 17% of graduate degree recipients indicated that they attended graduate/professional school after their graduation from Saint Rose
- ➤ 97% of those responding to their level of preparation for graduate/professional school, indicated that Saint Rose had prepared them for graduate studies
- > 74% of those responding to the internship question on the survey, indicated that they participated in an internship (including Student Teaching and Clinical Practicum) while attending Saint Rose
