Lisha Deming Glinsman '82

Glinsman, a chemistry major at Saint Rose, applies science to solving the curatorial puzzles of fine artworks. Working with other scientists, curators and conservators, she identifies the materials and techniques behind paintings, bronzes, photographs, porcelains and tapestries in the National



Gallery collection, and those loaned for exhibits. Museums across the globe also invite Glinsman to analyze their works, something she does with an X-ray fluorescence spectrometer, a hand-held instrument which penetrates many layers and hundreds of years.
