MATH PLACEMENT INSTRUCTION SHEET

Students entering the College of Saint Rose are required to go through Math Placement, unless...:


- they enter the College with a grade of "C-"
 or better in College Algebra, Pre-Calculus
 or Calculus course that carries college
 credit (note: Math or Science majors/
 concentrators are encouraged to take the
 Math Placement if they are only transferring in College Algebra).
- they enter the College with a "3" or better on an Advanced Placement test in Calculus.

(*Please Note*: College transcripts and/or AP test scores <u>must</u> be received prior to the Summer Orientation Session you plan to attend. Please mail transcript signed and sealed to:

College of Saint Rose, Office of Undergraduate Admissions, 432 Western Avenue, Albany, NY 12203)

First-year students living within two hours of The College of Saint Rose **must** take Math Placement prior to Summer Orientation. Students living *more* than two hours away are strongly encouraged to take Math Placement in advance, but may also elect to take it early on the first day of Orientation, if they so choose (check in time no later than 8:00am).

Frequently Asked Questions

Why does the College of Saint Rose require Math Placement?

The College requires students to go through Math Placement in order to ensure proper placement in math and science courses. (At Saint Rose, all students, regardless of major, need to satisfy requirements in each of these areas).

What's involved in Math Placement?

You will be asked questions on a variety of subjects, including pre-algebra, algebra, and calculus.

How long will it take?

You will have approximately one hour to complete Math Placement, although many students finish in a shorter time. You are free to go after you have completed Math Placement and received a copy of your results from the proctor.

Do I need to sign-up to take Math Placement at Summer Orientation?

No, you do not need to sign-up in advance to take Math Placement during Summer Orientation. Simply, plan to arrive by 8am sharp on your scheduled orientation day.

How can I prepare for Math Placement?

There are a number of ways to prepare. Reviewing exams and quizzes from your high school is a good place to start. You can also check study guides for the Regents exam in math, as well as for many college-level math courses. Finally, you can search the internet for online study sites.
