Graduate Scholarship Opportunities

Applicants for Master's degree study at The College of Saint Rose are encouraged to apply for the following Graduate Scholarships:

• Sister Anne L. Clark Scholarship

Who is eligible: New, full-time graduate students beginning in the Fall or Spring terms. Clark Scholarships are merit-based.

Program of Study: All.

Scholarship Range: The scholarship provides a one-half reduction of full-time tuition for two consecutive years or program completion, whichever comes first.

• Cultural Diversity Scholarship

Who is eligible: *New* graduate students beginning in the Fall or Spring terms, who identify themselves as culturally diverse or who demonstrate that they support cultural diversity through their education and career goals. Cultural Diversity Scholarships are merit-based.

Program of Study: All.

Scholarship Range: The scholarship provides for a one-half reduction of tuition for two consecutive years or program completion, whichever comes first.

• International Scholarship

Who is eligible: *New, full-time* international graduate students beginning in the Fall or Spring terms. International Scholarships are merit-based.

Program of Study: All.

Scholarship Range: The scholarship provides for a one-half reduction of full-time tuition for two consecutive years or program completion, whichever comes first.

• The Sacred Heart/Walter L. Hahn Scholarship

Who is eligible: *New or returning full-time matriculated* graduate students. The scholarship is based on academic excellence and financial need.

Program of Study: All.

Scholarship Range: The scholarship will provide \$1500.00 for one academic year (Fall and Spring). The scholarship is non-renewable.

• The George and Caroline Winkler Scholarship

Who is eligible: *Full-time matriculated* graduate students. **Program of Study:** Communication Sciences and Disorders.

Scholarship Range: The scholarship will provide \$500.00 for one academic year.

• Technology Education Scholarship

Who is eligible: New, part-time or full-time graduate Technology Education students.

Program of Study: Applied Technology Education.

Scholarship Range: The scholarship is a one-time award when funds are available.

• Peter M. and Anne M. Tully Endowed MBA Scholarship

Who is eligible: *New matriculated* MBA students. Preference is given to students employed in a business based in the Capital Region. Those students participating in employee reimbursement programs are ineligible.

Program of Study: Master of Business Administration.

Scholarship Range: The Tully Scholarship will provide tuition remission for nine graduate MBA credits in one academic year. This award is non-renewable.

• The Barbara Ann Carr Endowed Scholarship

Who is eligible: *New, part-time or full-time matriculated* graduate students pursuing a master's degree in the Fall semester. Preference is given to full-time students.
